Wednesday 20th June 2012 (10h30-14h)

This event will take place during the European Sustainable Energy Week - EUSEW 2012 at the premises of the Chamber of Commerce and Industry of the Rhône-Alpes region in Brussels.

It aims to present the best results of 6 European projects led by the training departments of CCI : Neopolis (Training for sustainable development of buildings and industries) and CFPF (Forestry Training);

4 European projects deal with the topic of energy efficient building: AlpHouse, REE_TROFIT, SCORE and TEAM ECOCONSTRUCTION. Addressing a wide range of stakeholders (SME, Architect, Planners, decision makers...), they aim to provide resources and tools for a comprehensive approach to energetic efficient building. Professionals and planners are addressed through innovative trainings for the strengthening of construction skills as well as strategic tools to implement renovation programs at the territorial level. How to combine the specificities of local architecture (Alpine, Mediterranean) with high efficiency and green solutions will be also discussed. Because low energy construction requires a new way of working, attendees will discover new professions specifically developed in favor of a more cooperative and holistic approach.

Energy efficiency will also address the industrial sector with the project EINSTEIN II: innovative auditing and analysis tools “EINSTEIN” for industrial process will be presented as well as best case studies.

The audience will be also displayed with the topics of wood energy and the use of Biomass through the Wood E3 project: the speaker will present the new solutions which have been created to support the sustainable development of this renewable energy: analysis tools, CO2 emissions calculator, online database for the networking of actors of wood energy.

The conference will be concluded by Michele RIVASI, MEP (the Greens, EFA). Attendees will be invited to join us for a cocktail made of local Drôme products. They will benefit from ongoing exchanging with Michele RIVASI and project managers, and pursuing cooperation opportunities in sustainable development projects.
